Boxes and pots should be placed against and be kept in good repair. Flower baskets need to hang so they do not impact sidewalks. BENCHES: SMC 19.12.070(G) – Benches may be constructed of dimensional lumber, and/or iron. They may be stained or painted a solid color, but may not includ lettering or advertising of any kind. Benches should be limited in number and place against the building, with only one 6' bench per 20 lineal feet. Wherever possible, benche should be placed off the boardwalk. Some good examples of period design benches ar currently in use at City Hall, Richter's and the White Pass Depot. Benches made in whol or part of plywood, plastic, or concrete are not allowed.
