Supporting Lemonade Day on Saturday, June 19, 2021

WHEREAS: Lemonade Day is a free, community-wide educational event to help prepare youth for life through fun, proactive, and experiential programs infused with life skills, character education, and entrepreneurship; and

WHEREAS: the foremost objective of Lemonade Day is to help today's youth become the business leaders, social advocates, community, volunteers, and forward-thinking citizens of tomorrow, building self-esteem and new mindsets that can propel youth to success; and

WHEREAS: Lemonade Day offers opportunities for families, businesses, schools, youth organizations, neighborhoods, institutes of higher learning, and government agencies to unite for a common purpose; and

WHEREAS: Lemonade Day is an event that demonstrates to young people of Skagway that they are important and that citizens care about their future; and

WHEREAS: to promote sustainable practices and support the municipal composting program, the Municipality of Skagway will donate 800 compostable cups for participants to use on Lemonade Day; and

WHEREAS: those participants registered for Lemonade Day activities are not required to obtain a business license or submit sales tax per SMC 4.08.060(4) and 5.04.010;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Andrew Cremata, Mayor of the Municipality of Skagway, do hereby proclaim Saturday, June 19, 2021, as "Lemonade Day" in Skagway and encourage all residents of the Skagway area to participate and have a role either selling or buying lemonade on that day.
