**MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA  
RESOLUTION NO. 21-28R**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA DECLARING THE PERIOD OF OCTOBER 1, 2021 THROUGH MARCH 31, 2022 AS A SALES TAX HOLIDAY FOR RETAIL SALES.**

**WHEREAS;** Skagway Municipal Code Chapter 4.08 authorizes the Borough Assembly to proclaim sales tax holidays on retail sales between October 1<sup>st</sup> and March 31<sup>st</sup>; and

**WHEREAS;** per SMC 4.08.005(A)(6), a “retail sale” means any sale of real or tangible personal property, including barter, credit, installment and conditional sales, for any purpose other than resale in the regular course of business; and

**WHEREAS;** the Borough Assembly wishes to give the community a holiday; and

**WHEREAS;** a sales tax holiday between the period of October 1, 2021 and March 31, 2022 would satisfy the requirements and qualifications of Skagway Municipal Code Chapter 4.08.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Skagway Borough Assembly declares the period of October 1, 2021, through March 31, 2022 as a sales tax holiday on all retail sales.
