Outdoor/Indoor Servicing Security Plan

1. All minors must be accompanied by an adult (over 21 years old) in the restricted area when any alcohol is being served, sold, or consumed.
2. All new patrons are carded upon ordering alcohol.
3. All staff is trained in the identification of fake IDs.
4. A cedar wood deck railing stands 58" from the ground level and 42" from the deck level.
5. Underaged persons will be monitored closely by our professionally trained alcohol servers.
6. Proper egress from the outdoor service area will always remain unobstructed.
7. As required by law, ABC-mandated posters are posted inside Woadie's South East Seafood LLC and at the entrances.
8. "NO ALCOHOL IS ALLOWED BEYOND THIS POINT" signs will be posted at all entrances and exits.
9. Keeping outdoor seating viable without any increased risk to minors exposed to alcohol will continue to be a part of our training.
10. Proper signage at the entry indicates no minors without a parent or legal guardian will be posted.
11. All servers will closely monitor that only the guests that have been ID'd will have alcoholic beverages.
12. Our top priority continues to provide safety for all guests regarding the service of alcoholic beverages.
13. will be present in the outdoor area to monitor consumption.
14. Alcohol and food will be served from inside the kitchen, through the service window, and consumed in the designated eating area.

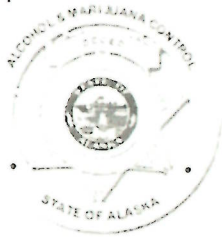

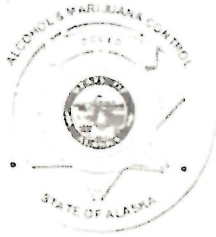

All employees receiving, serving, supervising, and customers handling and/or consuming alcohol will be 21 years of age or older. All employees 21 years old or older will be required to provide proof of and keep a valid (TAPS) card on file and exemplify proper alcohol management. Management will record all (TAPS) card expiration dates to ensure training and recertifying are done proactively. Employees under the age of 21 will never serve alcohol; however, they may clear tables, wash dishes, and dump glasses that contain alcohol. Underage employees can perform these tasks only if the remaining alcohol is discarded immediately and they are being supervised by a (TAPS) qualified employee.

Employees will be trained to properly check the I.D. of all customers who order or consume alcohol that does not appear to be over 35 years old. All staff members will be trained to identify and confront suspicious behavior that may lead to minors accessing alcohol. No underage customer or anyone showing signs of intoxication will be served alcohol. Any customers showing signs or symptoms of intoxication will be requested to exit the premises. Customers caught attempting to undermine our alcohol policies, passing alcohol over the deck railing, or providing alcohol to underage customers will be asked to leave the premises immediately, and local law enforcement will be informed of the incident. Any employees violating these standards will be terminated immediately. "No alcohol beyond this point" signage will be posted at every "Exit" and 'Emergency Exit.' The staff of all ages will be trained on the importance of responsible alcohol management and will be given the responsibility to report any wrongdoing to their supervisor. The staff of all ages will be trained to be vigilant throughout our customer's stay to ensure that they will not share the alcohol products with those who have no provided I.D. once they arrive at their table.

Our open floor plan paired with the viewpoint of our service window will provide excellent visibility to the seating area preventing the miss management of alcohol.

Employees will be trained to properly check the I.D. of all customers who order or consume alcohol that does not appear to be over 35 years old. All staff members will be trained to identify and confront suspicious behavior that may lead to minors accessing alcohol. No underage customer or anyone showing signs of intoxication will be served alcohol. Any customers showing signs or symptoms of intoxication will be requested to exit the premises. Customers caught attempting to undermine our alcohol policies, passing alcohol over the deck railing, or providing alcohol to underage customers will be asked to leave the premises immediately, and local law enforcement will be informed of the incident. Any employees violating these standards will be terminated immediately. "No alcohol beyond this point" signage will be posted at every "Exit" and 'Emergency Exit.' The staff of all ages will be trained on the importance of responsible alcohol management and will be given the responsibility to report any wrongdoing to their supervisor. The staff of all ages will be trained to be vigilant throughout our customer's stay to ensure that they will not share the alcohol products with those who have no provided I.D. once they arrive at their table.

Our open floor plan paired with the viewpoint of our service window will provide excellent visibility to the seating area preventing the miss management of alcohol.
