Pursuant to SMC 5.12.040 Recommendation by assembly – Application, I hereby certify that the Chilkoot Trail Outpost has paid in full any and all taxes, fees, assessments, utility bills and remittance of sales tax due to the municipality.

Conditional Use Permit No. 17-12 was approved by the Planning & Zoning Commission on March 16, 2017, which permits the Chilkoot Trail Outpost to have a restaurant and utilize a beverage dispensary – tourism liquor license on USS 3414.

Notice from the Alcohol & Marijuana Control Office was received on December 1, 2022 and the Assembly has 60 days to protest this package store liquor license pursuant to the notice of application from the State of Alaska.
