Dear Assembly Members,

During our last two meetings on July 27, 2023 and August 24, 2023 the Skagway Visitors Advisory Board has discussed at length and would like to make the following recommendations:

- 1.) That a budget line item might be put into place for Winter, holiday lights for the downtown area and the road leading to the ferry terminal.
- 2.) To set up a work session with Public Safety and the SVAB for Wednesday, September 27, 2023 at 5:30pm to discuss solutions to the safety concerns the SVAB has regarding the intersection on 2nd Avenue and Broadway Street. One of our recommendation is to have a crossing guard placed their during peak hours.
- 3.) That a portion of the Garden City RV Park be dedicated to RV dry parking in 2024, so that reservations for the 2024 season can start to be taken.
- 4.) In addition, we recommend that the contract dates for the facilitators of the RV park be altered, to better suit for the upcoming year's facilitators, bookings, as well as, the ramp up time needed for this department to run smoothly.
- 5.)Furthermore, that the future plans for Garden City RV Park become a priority and be included on future assembly agendas until a solution has been made to either keep GCRV Park, or determine a new site for a new RV park. The SVAB is in unison on the fact that we believe the independent traveler is important to our business community and to the municipality's economy!
