### MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA RESOLUTION NO. 23-30R

# A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA EXPRESSING INTENT TO DISPOSE OF BLOCKS 95 AND 102, KNOWN AS THE GARDEN CITY RV PARK.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Skagway owns the property at Blocks 95 & 102 (Property), currently known as the Garden City RV Park; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality wishes to express its intent to dispose of the Property for benefit of the public; and

WHEREAS, future development of the properties has been an ongoing discussion by the Borough Assembly, and administration requires direction regarding how to manage the property; and

**WHEREAS,** the Municipality understands that there is a need for high-density housing in the community, as well as a general need to sell municipal land for residential use, and the Skagway Traditional Council has requested that <u>at least</u> one\_lot of the Garden City property be reserved for the creation of a memorial.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Skagway Borough Assembly expresses its intent to dispose of Blocks 95 and 102, <u>a process which will tentatively begin in 2025</u>, and <u>requests</u> Administration to proceed as follows:


- Subdivide Blocks 95 and 102 into twenty four <u>sixteen (16)</u> (24) 5,000-square-foot parcels, and (4) <u>10,000 square foot lots</u> with the Sixteenth Avenue municipal right-of-way designated. ;
- Designate six (6) 5,000 ft lots for Skagway residents who are first time home buyers as defined by Housing Urban Development (HUD);
- Reserve and make available one (1) two (2) 5,000 square foot parcels for use as a memorial site, to acknowledge and commemorate the existence and operation of the Pius X Mission Residential Boarding School;
- Provide for the disposal of four (4) <u>10,000 square foot</u> parcels <u>located with-in the Business General</u> <u>zoning to the public by lottery</u>, for the purpose of <u>high-density-multiple-family</u> housing, with requirements in place for purchaser(s) to develop housing to the Municipality's specifications;
- Provide for the disposal of all remaining <u>5,000 square-foot</u> parcels to the public by lottery, with no requirements for development.


