To our Skagway residents,

As you may or may not know Alaska Power and Telephone is looking to relocate the sub marine cable connecting Skagway to Kasidaya into the Smugglers cove area. The current cable is located on the waterfront and this move serves to both protect the cable from natural slides in the area and we will be out of the way of the Municipal plans to expand and build the waterfront the way they would like to see it. The sub cable relocation is looking like it will happen in June of 2023. To facilitate this, we are needing to rebuild our lines along the Dyea road and in doing so we have to replace all the poles from the start of the Dyea road to approximately the AB Mountain trailhead. We have contracted Sturgeon Electric and they will be moving crews into the area starting today and you should start seeing them along the road later in the week. Please slow down in the work zones and watch for both the flaggers and workers that will be in the area. Right now, the crews will be working 6am to 6pm 7 days a week, this is subject to change as daylight diminishes.

While doing this work, crews are striving to limit the number of outages customers will experience. When planned outages are required, our staff will try to reach out to the affected customers with a minimum of 24 hours' notice.

We are sorry for any inconvenience this will cause our customer but please bear with us while we upgrade our system to bring a better product to our customers.
