SELF-ISOLATION ORDER EXTENDED TO JUNE 4

Skagway, Alaska, May 22, 2020 – At its meeting of May 21, 2020, the Borough Assembly adopted <u>Resolution No. 20-17R</u>, which extends Skagway's self-isolation order to **June 4**, **2020**, at which time it will be re-evaluated. The following guidelines are in place:

- Any person traveling into the Skagway Borough from outside of Alaska, or from any community with known cases of COVID-19 within the prior 14 days, will self-isolate for 14 days upon arrival in Skagway.
- A person traveling from an Alaskan community with no known cases of COVID-19 does NOT need to self-isolate upon arrival in Skagway.

"Self-Isolation" means do not go to work, school, or public areas. Do not have visitors, such as friends and family, where you are self-isolating. Do not go out to buy food, visit the post office, or collect medicine – order them by phone or online, or ask someone else to drop them off at your self-isolation location.

Please continue to follow the social distancing guidelines, wear masks in public, practice good hygiene and be respectful of your neighbors. Your efforts have allowed us to maintain **zero** confirmed cases in our community.

<u>Resolution No. 20-17R</u> also sets minimum standards for allowing cruise ship visitation in Skagway in 2020 and 2021. Please see the resolution for more information.
