THREE POSITIVE COVID-19 CASES IN SKAGWAY

Skagway, Alaska, August 23, 2021 – The Dahl Memorial Clinic has been informed of three new positive COVID-19 cases in Skagway related to a recent positive case. The new positive cases had quarantined quickly when identified as close contacts of the initial positive case, and the State DHSS is currently conducting contact tracing. **There is always concern for community spread.**

Anyone who is symptomatic should contact DMC at 907-983-2255 to schedule testing during regular business hours.

All community members, including those who are vaccinated, are reminded to wash your hands, social distance, wear a mask in public settings where other social distancing measures are difficult to maintain, and get tested if you are sick.
