AMENDED TRAVEL MANDATE FOR ALL TRAVELERS ARRIVING IN SKAGWAY

Skagway, Alaska, January 22, 2021 – At its meeting of January 21, 2021, the Skagway Assembly adopted <u>Resolution No. 21-04R</u>, which provides COVID-19 travel mandate exemptions for critical business. The critical business or entity exemption reads as follows:

Section 5. Critical Business or Entity Exemption. People who are engaged with critical business shall request an exemption from Skagway's COVID-19 testing and strict social distancing requirements, as detailed in this resolution, from the borough manager or acting manager prior to bringing exempt workers to Skagway. All workers are still required to comply with all Federal and State health mandates and orders. Critical business or entities are the following:

- a. Transportation and logistics
- b. Government functions
- c. Alaska Power & Telephone Co.
