Mission Statement

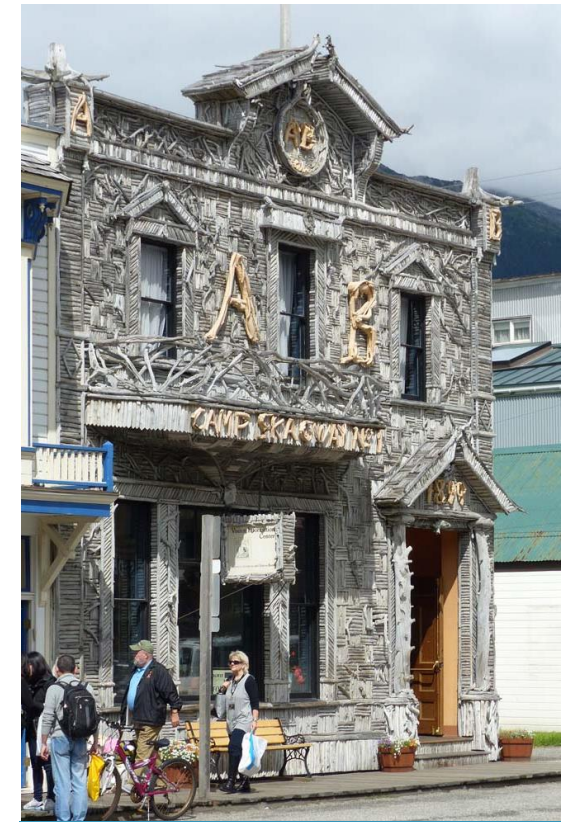
