AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA AMENDING THE FY11 SALES TAX BUDGET TO ALLOCATE \$45,000 TO FUND THE SKAGWAY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE OFFICE MANAGER POSITION

WHEREAS, a reallocation of funds in the FY11 Sales Tax Budget is requested as follows:

1. Sales Tax – a one-time allocation of \$45,000 to fund the office manager position at the Skagway Chamber of Commerce.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. To amend the FY11 Sales Tax Budget to allocate \$45,000 to fund the office manager position at the Skagway Chamber of Commerce.

Section 3. Amendment. The FY11 Sales Tax Budget is hereby amended as follows:
