# AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA AMENDING THE FY11 CAPITAL PROJECTS. TOURISM. LAND AND EQUIPMENT BUDGETS

WHEREAS, an increase to the FY11 Budget is necessary as follows:

- 1. Capital Projects ARCS Repair \$5,500 to repair ARCS equipment so residents will have access to the rural television network again.
- 2. Capital Projects Wave Barrier \$170,000 to pay the settlement reached with Pacific Pile and Marine.
- 3. Tourism/Sales Tax Budget Transfer \$25,000 from Sales Tax to tourism for the writer's symposium.
- 4. Equipment Budget \$20,000 to put amount in reserve for police department vehicle to be purchased in FY12. This was overlooked in the original budget.
- 5. Land Fund \$25,178 for the change order #1 for Southeast Roadbuilders on the Taiya Inlet Subdivision Improvements project.
- 6. Code Re-Write \$5,000 to carry forward funding for the code re-write project.

# NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

**Section 2.** Purpose. To amend the FY11 Budget to include Capital Projects; ARCS Repair, and additional Wave Barrier funding, Code Re-Write, add an additional \$25,000 to the tourism budget for a writers' symposium, include \$20,000 in the equipment budget for police department vehicle reserve, and add \$25,178 for a change order for Southeast Roadbuilders for the Taiya Inlet Subdivision improvements
