MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA ORDINANCE NO. 10-12

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA AMENDING THE FY11 SALES TAX BUDGET TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF FUNDING APPROPRIATED FOR THE SKAGWAY SCHOOL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, an increase to the Sales Tax Budget is necessary as follows:

1. School Foundation Formula Funding – To increase the amount of local funding for the general operations of the school budget as per the request originally submitted by the Skagway School District.
2. School Program Funding – To increase the amount of local funding for programs outside the operating budget as per the request originally submitted by the Skagway School District.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. To amend the FY11 Budget to increase the amount of Sales Tax Funding appropriated for the Skagway School District

Section 3. Amendment. The FY11 Sales Tax Budget is hereby amended as follows.



Expense: SCHOOL–Ex.Activity/FoodSvc/Tech	\$353,054	\$250,000
Total Expenses:	\$4,725,672	\$4,774,398

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
