ORDINANCE NO. 10-09

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA ADOPTING THE REVISED DYEFLATS LAND MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY.

WHEREAS, the purpose of Dyea Flats Land Management Plan is

1. Provides background information about the Flats that is important to understand when managing the area;
2. Sets forth the Municipality's goals for management;
3. Lists uses that are allowed, allowed with a municipal permit, and prohibited;
4. Details implementation actions that the Municipality may take to manage the property ;and
5. Lists some funding sources that may be available.

WHEREAS, the Dyea Community Advisory Board worked with the National Park Service Rivers, Trails and Conservation Assistance Program, Taiya Inlet Watershed Council and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Coastal Conservation Program in preparing the Revised Dyea Flats Land Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Revised Dyea Flats Land Management Plan addresses the goals set out in the 1996 Dyea Flats Land Management Plan by revision and addition to as well as including objectives for each goal; and

WHEREAS, the Revised Dyea Flats Land Management Plan establishes a 5-Year Action Plan and Management Oversight; and

WHEREAS, the Dyea Community Advisory Board held a public hearing on the Draft Revised Dyea Flats Land Management Plan on March 15, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Planning & Zoning Commission held public hearings on the Draft Revised Dyea Flats Land Management Plan on April 7 and May 13, 2010;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Municipality of Skagway, Alaska as follows:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. To adopt the Revised Dyea Flats Land Management Plan dated June 17, 2010 for the Municipality of Skagway.

Section 3. Organization. The Revised Dyea Flats Land Management Plan is organized in 6 parts and 6 appendices:

Part 1. Introduction outlines the process that was used to develop the plan;

Part 2. Existing Conditions provides information on natural resources, vegetation, wildlife, aquatic habitat, cultural/historic resources, current recreational and other uses of the Dyea Flats.

Part 3. Existing Code outlines the legal provisions for managing the flats.

Part 4. Chronology of Dyea Flats Planning outlines past planning and public involvement and other plans governing management of the Dyea Flats.

Part 5. Revised Dyea Flats Land Management Plan outlines goals and objectives and the Dyea Flats 5-Year Action Plan.

Part 6 Plan Administration outlines management oversight, contributors and abbreviations.

Section 4. Adoption. The Revised Dyea Flats Land Management Plan dated June 17, 2010 is hereby adopted by reference.


