**MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA  
ORDINANCE NO. 13-10**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA AMENDING THE FY13 SALES TAX FUND AND CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND BUDGETS TO ALLOCATE FUNDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE ORIGINAL CITY HALL BUILDING.**

**WHEREAS**, when the City of Skagway was incorporated in 1900, City Hall was housed in the building located at 350 5th Ave., Lot 8, Block 2; and

**WHEREAS**, the historic building is currently for sale at the price of \$140,000, with closing costs estimated at \$2,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Assembly wishes to secure the property to protect the building's historic resource; and

**WHEREAS**, amendments to the FY13 Sales Tax Fund and Capital Projects Fund budgets are needed to allocate funding for the purchase of the building;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Classification.** This is a non-code ordinance.

**Section 2. Purpose.** To amend the FY13 Sales Tax Fund and Capital Projects Fund budgets to allocate funding for the purchase of the property at 350 5th Ave., Lot 8, Block 2, Skagway Townsite.

**Section 3. Amendment.** The FY13 Municipality of Skagway Sales Tax Fund and Capital Projects Fund budgets are hereby amended as follows:
