MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA ORDINANCE NO. 12-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA AMENDING THE FY12 SALES TAX BUDGET TO ALLOCATE FUNDING FOR A MUNICIPAL PARKING LOT.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Skagway has identified a need to reduce vehicle congestion in the downtown area due to limited parking along public streets; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly wishes to provide a municipal parking lot to help decrease the volume of vehicles parking on downtown streets during the summer season; and

WHEREAS, the Westmark Hotel has offered to lease its parking lot at 2nd Avenue and Spring Street to the Municipality of Skagway at the rate of \$25,000 per year; and

WHEREAS, a budget amendment is needed to allocate funding for the lease in FY12;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. To amend the FY12 Sales Tax Budget to allocate funding to lease the parking lot at 2nd Avenue and Spring Street from Westmark Hotel.

Section 3. Amendment. The FY12 Municipality of Skagway Budget is hereby amended as follows:
