## MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA

### ORDINANCE NO. 11-25

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA AMENDING TITLE 10 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC BY AMENDING SECTION 10.02.045(A) ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES.

**WHEREAS**, municipal code section 10.02.045(A) defines an all terrain vehicle as having three or four wheels only; and

**WHEREAS**, municipal code should be amended to allow for the instance of an all terrain vehicle with more than four wheels;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Classification.** This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Skagway Municipal Code.

**Section 2. Purpose.** To amend Title 10, Vehicles and Traffic, by amending section 10.02.045(A) All Terrain Vehicles.

**Section 3. Amendment.** The Skagway Municipal Code is hereby amended (~~strike through~~) indicates text to be deleted from and (**bold underscore**) indicates text added to the current code. Title 10 Vehicles and Traffic Chapter 10.02.045 All Terrain Vehicles is hereby amended as follows:

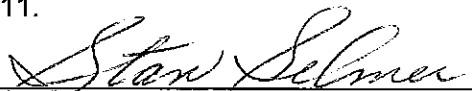
**10.02.045 All Terrain Vehicles**

- A. Definition. An All Terrain Vehicle (ATV) is any motorized ~~three or four wheeled~~ vehicle **with three or more wheels** other than an automobile, truck, sport utility vehicle, motorcycle, motor home or golf cart.


**Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

**Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
