MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA ORDINANCE NO. 11-23

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA AMENDING THE FY12 SALES TAX BUDGET TO INCREASE FUNDING FOR LILLEGRAVEN CREEK MITIGATION, ARCS SITE RELOCATION AND TAIYA INLET WATERSHED COUNCIL FUNDING.

WHEREAS, an increase to the sales tax budget for Lillegraven Creek mitigation, ARCS site relocation and Taiya Inlet Watershed Council funding is necessary to cover costs in excess of the adopted FY12 budget.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. To amend the FY12 Budget to increase the amount of sales tax funding available for Lillegraven Creek mitigation, ARCS site relocation and Taiya Inlet Watershed Council funding.

Section 3. Amendment. The FY12 Municipality of Skagway Budget is hereby amended as follows:
