**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SKAGWAY CITY COUNCIL NAMING THE SKAGWAY RECREATION CENTER PLAYGROUND AND SKATE PARK TO BE KNOWN HENCEFORTH AS VOLUNTEER PARK.**

**WHEREAS**, volunteers played an integral role in the creation and success of the Skagway Recreation Center; and

**WHEREAS**, it was volunteers that formed the initial committee that worked to preserve the old school gym with a vision of building a community recreation center; and

**WHEREAS**, volunteers managed to keep the building and grounds open for rollerblading, basketball, yoga, and many other healthful activities; and

**WHEREAS**, volunteers taught classes, painted rooms, erected fencing, setup playground equipment, landscaped the grounds, and constructed the first skate park ramps; and

**WHEREAS**, the Skagway Recreation Center has become a cornerstone for the physical and mental wellbeing of our community; and

**WHEREAS**, to honor the efforts volunteers have made to make this facility such a success,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Skagway City Council that:

1. The City of Skagway recognizes the positive benefits volunteers have made in the community; and
2. Henceforth the Skagway Recreation Center Playground and Skate Park will be known as **Volunteer Park**; and
3. A suitability engraved sign will be erected at the park to acknowledge the efforts of our community volunteers.
