## MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA RESOLUTION NO. 07-19R

A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA SEEKING RECREATIONAL TRAILS GRANT FUNDING FOR ASSISTANCE WITH THE RESTORATION OF THE UPPER DEWEY LAKE TRAIL FACILITIES.

**WHEREAS,** The Municipality of Skagway maintains several trails all of which have been identified in the Skagway Comprehensive Trails Plan; and

**WHEREAS,** It is the objective of the Municipality of Skagway to restore and maintain these trails; and

**WHEREAS,** the current condition of the Upper Dewey Lake Trail outhouse facilities are marginal at best with a significant amount of restoration required to rebuild it to a level where future maintenance and development will require minimal efforts; and

**WHEREAS,** Replacement of outhouse facilities is a critical component to the multi-year project and will protect an environmentally sensitive alpine meadow and drainage system; and

WHEREAS, it will add a major element to full enjoyment of the trail; and

**WHEREAS,** this maintenance work will be expensive to develop the trail to the standards that trail users expect;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Borough Assembly of the Municipality of Skagway supports efforts to secure Recreational Trails Grant funding from the Department of Natural Resources, Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreation.
