A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA DESIGNATING THE DAHL MEMORIAL CLINIC RELOCATION AND EXPANSION AS THE COMMUNITY PRIORITY PROJECT FOR FUNDING FROM THE COMMERCIAL PASSENGER VESSEL EXCISE TAX IMPACT FUND.

WHEREAS, Construction of a new clinic in Skagway will provide a much needed health care facility that will provide service to passengers, crew, seasonal workers, and regional residents; and

WHEREAS, Skagway has committed \$4 million in local funds and the State of Alaska has authorized a grant in the amount of \$1 million;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Municipality of Skagway Borough Assembly has designated the Dahl Memorial Clinic relocation and expansion as the Community Priority Project for funding from the Commercial Passenger Vessel Excise Tax Impact Fund in the amount of \$2 million.
