RESOLUTION NO. 07-25R

A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA DESIGNATING THE BOOSTER STATION AND WELL AS THE COMMUNITY PRIORITY PROJECT FOR FUNDING FROM THE STATE CAPITAL PROGRAM BUDGET.

WHEREAS, Due to inadequate water pressures at the higher elevations of the community's water system, Skagway is looking at constructing a new well and water booster pump station; and

WHEREAS, A booster station and well would create more stable pressure and provide water for firefighting purposes; and

WHEREAS, This project will cost an estimated \$1 million and the Municipality has a \$250,000 earmark from EPA to put towards completion of this project; and

WHEREAS, Governor Palin vetoed the Booster Station and Well in 2007 but this project remains a priority for the community due to safety and health concerns;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Municipality of Skagway Borough Assembly has designated the Booster Station and Well as the Community Priority Project for funding from the State Capital Program Budget in the amount of \$650,000.
