RESOLUTION NO. 07-26R

A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA DESIGNATING THE SMALL BOAT HARBOR RENOVATION AND PARTIAL PENETRATING WAVE BARRIER AS THE PROJECTS PROPOSED BY THE COMMUNITY FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE STATE OF ALASKA HARBOR MUNICIPAL HARBOR FACILITY GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, This project has several components in its first phase; construction of a partial penetrating wave barrier, replacement, and extension of floating docks, and maintenance dredging; and

WHEREAS, This facility was transferred from the State to the Municipality with a great deal of accompanying deferred maintenance; and

WHEREAS, Skagway has a \$500,000 grant from the Denali Commission to help fund the wave barrier project; and

WHEREAS, The Municipality of Skagway is willing to partner with the State of Alaska to deal with the deferred maintenance issues left lingering after transfer of the facility to the community;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Municipality of Skagway Borough Assembly urges the Legislature to provide substantial funds to the grant program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Municipality of Skagway Borough Assembly nominates the Skagway Small Boat Harbor Renovation and Partial Penetrating Wave Barrier for funding under the matching grant program in the amount of \$14 million.
