**A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA DECLARING THE PERIOD OF NOVEMBER 26, 2010, THROUGH FEBRUARY 28, 2011, AS A SALES TAX HOLIDAY.**

**WHEREAS;** Skagway Municipal Code Chapter 4.08 authorizes the Borough Assembly to proclaim sales tax holidays between October 1st and March 31st, and

**WHEREAS;** the Borough Assembly wishes to give the community a holiday, and


