RESOLUTION NO. 12-19R**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA, SUPPORTING A FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF HYDRO-ELECTRICITY IN WEST CREEK AND AUTHORIZING ADMINISTRATION TO SUBMIT A RENEWABLE ENERGY FUND GRANT APPLICATION TO THE ALASKA ENERGY AUTHORITY (AEA) TO SECURE FUNDING.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Skagway wishes to pursue a feasibility study to determine if hydro-electricity can be generated from West Creek; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Skagway will approve an \$84,000 expenditure in the FY 2014 budget to serve as the required match for the Renewable Energy Fund Grant.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Municipality of Skagway supports a feasibility study for the development of hydro-electricity in West Creek and authorizes administration to submit a Renewable Energy Fund grant application to the AEA to secure funding.
