**MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA
RESOLUTION NO. 12-20R**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA DECLARING THE PERIOD OF NOVEMBER 1, 2012, THROUGH MARCH 31, 2013, AS A SALES TAX HOLIDAY.


WHEREAS; Skagway Municipal Code Chapter 4.08 authorizes the Borough Assembly to proclaim sales tax holidays between October 1st and March 31st; and

WHEREAS; the Borough Assembly wishes to give the community a holiday; and

WHEREAS; a sales tax holiday between the period of November 1, 2012, and March 31, 2013, would satisfy the requirements and qualifications of Skagway Municipal Code Chapter 4.08.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Skagway Borough Assembly declares the period of November 1, 2012, through March 31, 2013, as a sales tax holiday.
