## MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA RESOLUTION NO. 13-19R

# A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 12-02R, AND AMENDING PARKING ZONES ON SEVENTH AVENUE AND BROADWAY STREET.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that Resolution No. 12-02r is hereby repealed and replaced with the following;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Skagway Borough Assembly establish the following modifications to parking zones, strike through indicates text deleted and **<u>bold/underline</u>** indicates text added to the current regulations for the Municipality of Skagway to become effective upon adoption:

A. Restricted Parking, Timed Parking, Loading Zones and No Parking Zones. The following restricted parking zones are established and, unless otherwise noted, shall be in effect daily during the period from May 1<sup>st</sup> to October 1<sup>st</sup> from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

- 1. One hour parking:
  - a. East and west side of Broadway from 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue unless designated otherwise.
  - b. West side of Broadway beginning 50 feet from the alley between 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue.
  - c. North side of 6th Avenue from Spring Street toward Broadway in front of municipally owned lots (Mollie Walsh Park).
  - d. South side of 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue between State Street and Broadway.

#### 2. 20-minute parking:

## a. West side of Broadway 100 feet south from 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue to the alley between 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

- 2<u>3</u>. Loading zones:
  - a. North side of 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue east from Broadway commencing at the lot line between Lots 8 and 9 of Block 35 and continuing east for 125 feet.
  - b. North side of 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue beginning at the lot line between lot 10 and lot 11, Block 34 east for 92.3 feet. In effect 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
  - c. North side of 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue east from Broadway commencing 30-feet from the stop sign and continuing to the lot line between Lots 8 and 9, Block 25 on Tuesdays only from May through September.
  - d. East side of Broadway from the alley between 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue. In effect 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
  - e. South side of 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue east from State Street commencing 20 feet from the corner of State and 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue and continuing for 50 feet east.
  - f. West side of Broadway 100 feet south from 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue to the alley between 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
  - g. West side of Congress Way east of the south ramp to the small boat harbor running north and south for 212 feet loading only.
  - h. North and south sides of 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue for 150 feet west of the corner of Spring Street loading zone (Westmark). In effect 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon.
  - i. North side of 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue beginning 20 feet from the corner of Broadway & 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue and continuing east for 100 feet.
  - <u>j.</u> South side of 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue beginning 20 feet from the corner of Broadway & 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue and continuing west for 100 feet. In effect 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.
  - jk. North side of 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue beginning at the east corner of Lot 9, Block 3 continuing west for 30 feet.
  - **<u>kl</u>**. East side of Broadway beginning at 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue continuing north for 50 feet.

- **<u>34</u>**. SMART Stop zones:
  - a. East side of Broadway for 75 feet south from 3rd Avenue (ending at the northern side of the Skagway News Depot entrance).
  - b. West side of Broadway from the corner of 5<sup>th</sup> Ave. and proceeding north 80 feet.
  - c. West side of Broadway beginning at 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and proceeding south for 75 feet.
  - d. East side of Broadway from the alley between 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Avenues and proceeding south 80 feet.
  - e. East side of Spring Street and 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue in front of the Museum entrance into the McCabe Building.
  - f. West side of Broadway beginning at the corner of 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue proceeding north 100 feet.
  - g. West side of State Street beginning at the corner of 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue proceeding north 60 feet.
  - h. West side of Congress Way beginning at the north end of the circular turn-around by the Railroad Dock and continuing southeast for 110 feet.
  - i. Beginning near the power pole extending south about 100 feet across from the Southern Pedestrian Access Bridge at the Ore Terminal Dock.
  - j. North side of 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue beginning at the corner of Spring Street proceeding west for 75 feet.
  - k. South side of 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue beginning 115 feet from the corner of Broadway & 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and continuing east for 94 feet.
- 4<u>5</u>. Oversized vehicles:
  - a. East and west side of Broadway from 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue to 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue no vehicles in excess of 19 feet in length.
- 5<u>6</u>. No Parking at any time:
  - a. No parking south of the alley between 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue and 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue on the East and West side of Broadway.
  - b. Both sides of Congress Way to the intersection with Spring Street unless otherwise designated.
  - c. Beginning at the railroad tracks in the alley between 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue continuing north for 50 feet on the East and West side of Broadway, no parking, stopping or standing.
  - d. West side of Broadway beginning at the alley between 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue continuing north to 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
- 6<u>7</u>. Other Restrictions:
  - a. West side of Broadway 30 feet south of the alley between 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue in front of AB Hall to be designated "Visitor's Center Staff Vehicle Only".
  - b. West side of Congress Way north of the public bathrooms, west of the load only zone by the south ramp to the small boat harbor, small boat harbor parking only. Parking is for small boat harbor users only and not to be used for commercial passenger vehicles. Unless otherwise noted this parking is limited to 24 hours.

B. Restricted Parking, Timed Parking, Loading and Drop Off Zones. The following restricted parking zones are established to be in effect year round.

- 1. Restricted Parking:
  - a. One parking space on the north side of City Hall parking lot Handicapped parking.
  - b. South side of 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue for 20 feet west from Broadway, one car length- Handicapped parking.
  - c. North and south side of 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue for 100 feet west of State Street No Parking, Fire Department Personnel Only.
  - d. East and West side of State Street south 100 feet from the Alley between 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue No Parking.
  - e. South side of 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue for 150 feet west from Spring Street No Parking.

- f. South small boat harbor parking lot, first two parking spaces on the south end Handicapped parking.
- g. West side of Main Street commencing at the north side of the alley between 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue and continuing north for 28 feet ending 72 feet from the corner of 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue Handicapped parking.
- 2. Timed Parking:
  - a. West side of Broadway for 100 feet north of corner of 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue 20 minute parking.
  - b. East side of Broadway for 100 feet north of corner of 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue 20 minute parking.
  - c. East side of Broadway from 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue excluding the SMART Stop 20 minute parking.
  - d. South side of 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue from State Street commencing 12 feet from the curb cut and continuing to the lot line between Lots 4 and 5, Block 37 20 minute parking.
  - e. South side of 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue beginning 191 feet from the corner of Broadway & 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and continuing east for 59 feet 20 minute parking.
  - f. North side of 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue east from Broadway (except for the curb cut) commencing 30feet from the stop sign and continuing to the lot line between Lots 8 and 9 of Block 35 – 20 minute parking restricted to vehicles of 19 feet or less.
  - g. South side of 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue commencing 70 feet from the corner of State Street and continuing east for 260 feet ending 20 feet from the corner of Broadway 20 minute parking.
  - h. South small boat harbor parking lot, north three parking spaces is limited to 30 minute parking.
  - i. North side of 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue commencing 20 feet from the corner of State Street and continuing east for 126 feet ending 154 feet from the corner of Broadway 20 minute parking.
  - j. North side of 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue commencing 100 feet from the corner of State Street and continuing east 200 feet to the corner of Broadway 1 hour parking.
- 3. Loading Zones:
  - a. East side of Broadway for 50 feet south of corner of 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue.
  - b. South side of 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue beginning 20 feet from the corner of Broadway & 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and continuing east for 95 feet.
  - c. South side of 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue beginning 20 feet from the corner of Broadway & 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue and continuing west for 50 feet.
- 4. No Parking at any time:
  - a. South side of 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue from State Street commencing at the curb cut and continuing for 12 feet.
  - b. East and west side of State Street within 20 feet of all intersections between 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue and 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue.
  - c. East and west side of Broadway Street from the intersection of 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue and continuing north for 100 feet to the southeast corner of Lot 1, Block 89 and the southwest corner of Lot 6, Block 88.

C. Loading zones shall be available for use by all vehicles (both private and commercial) unless otherwise designated.

- 1. Loading zones time limits
  - a. Active loading/unloading of freight or passengers for up to 30 minutes.
