Violation of AAC 02.395 Riding on bicycles and certain nonmotorized conveyances:	\$50.00 / each incident
Violation of AAC 02.400 Riding bicycles on roadways and bicycle paths:	\$50.00 / each incident
Bicycle parked where prohibited violation:	\$25.00 / each incident
All terrain vehicle regulation violation:	\$100.00 / each incident
Snowmobiles regulation violation:	\$100.00 / each incident
Golf cart and golf cart type vehicles regulation violation:	\$100.00 / each incident
Parked trailer violation:	\$25.00 / each day
Vehicle parked for more than 30 days:	\$50.00 / each day
Parked disabled vehicle:	\$50.00 / each day
Damaging surface of street or sidewalk:	\$100.00 plus repairs
Failure to exercise due care:	\$100.00 / each incident
Riding coasters, roller-skates, skateboards, sleds, skis and similar devices on unpermitted streets:	\$25.00 / each incident
Riding coasters, roller-skates, skateboards, sleds, skis and similar devices at night:	\$25.00 / each incident
