ORDINANCE NO. 18-23

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA AMENDING THE FY19 GENERAL FUND, HEALTH CLINIC FUND, COMMERCIAL PASSENGER VESSEL EXCISE TAX FUND, SALES TAX FUND, AND CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND TO ACCOUNT FOR GRANT AND DONATION REVENUE, AND TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR VARIOUS MUNICIPAL PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the Assembly has approved work on various municipal projects that necessitates the addition or adjustment of funding to the FY19 budget for: fire alarm panel upgrade project, which was delayed from FY18; the wave barrier inspection; State Street utility upgrades; the expansion of the Mollie Walsh restroom; a municipal match for the State's ferry float replacement project; and the paving of the Public Safety Facility parking lot, Eleventh Avenue, and Twelfth Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Dahl Memorial Clinic received additional 330 HRSA grant funds and the Municipality received donations for the Princess Sophia memorial project, both of which should be reflected in the budget;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. <u>Purpose</u>. To amend the FY19 General Fund, Health Clinic Fund, Commercial Passenger Vessel (CPV) Fund, Sales Tax Fund, and Capital Projects Fund budgets to account for grant and donation revenue, and to provide funding for various municipal projects.
