A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA SUPPORTING THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU IN ITS EFFORTS TO APPEAL THE DECISION IN *CRUISE LINES INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION ALASKA / CRUISE LINES INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION V. CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA*, CASE NO. 1:16-cv-00008-HRH.

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau (CBJ) has until March 26, 2019 to appeal the decision in Cruise Lines International Association Alaska / Cruise Lines International Association (CLIA) v. City and Borough of Juneau (CBJ), Case No. 1:16-cv-00008-HRH; and

WHEREAS, on January 3, 2019, the City of Ketchikan pledged \$100,000 as financial support for CBJ's appeal efforts; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Skagway recognizes that the decision in *CLIA v. CBJ* may have important implications on the planning for the Port of Skagway and on the cruise passenger experience in Skagway and throughout Southeast Alaska; and


WHEREAS, the Municipality of Skagway supports CBJ in its efforts to appeal the decision; and


