**MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA
ORDINANCE NO. 19-10**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA AMENDING THE FY19 SALES TAX FUND AND CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND BUDGETS TO ACCOUNT FOR DONATION REVENUE AND ADDITIONAL FUNDS TO COVER THE COST OF THE HISTORIC CITY HALL LEAD-BASED PAINT ABATEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the historic city hall lead-based paint abatement project was approved by the Assembly on February 7, 2019 for a total cost of \$44,888, but only \$35,000 was budgeted in FY19; and

WHEREAS, \$1,157 in revenue from historic city hall rummage sale, \$4,321 from unspent sales tax funding for the Princess Sophia project, and \$4,410 in additional sales tax funding has been designated to cover the overage for the lead-based paint abatement project;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. To amend the FY19 Sales Tax Fund and Capital Projects Fund budgets to account for donation revenue and additional funds to cover the cost of the historic city hall lead-based paint abatement project.

Section 3. Amendment. The FY19 Municipality of Skagway Budget is hereby amended as follows:
