**MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA
RESOLUTION NO. 19-28R**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA, DECLARING THE MUNICIPALITY'S INTENT TO ISSUE A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT, USE, AND PRESERVATION OF THE PORT OF SKAGWAY AND MUNICIPAL TIDELANDS, AND FOR TRANSITION FROM THE CURRENT LEASE.

WHEREAS, the long-term lease of municipal tidelands expires in March of 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality has been planning for, and intends to continue planning and transitioning for, use of the Port of Skagway, municipal tidelands, and waterfront after March of 2023; and

WHEREAS, current users of the Port of Skagway and its waterfront have expressed uncertainty regarding their future utilization of the port and transition from the current long-term lease after March of 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality has hired Bermello, Ajamil and Partners (B&A) to assist with the development and planning of the Port of Skagway, tidelands, and waterfront; and

WHEREAS, with assistance from B&A, the Municipality plans to issue a Request for Proposals (RFP) for the development, use, and preservation of the Port of Skagway and municipal tidelands, and for transition from the current long-term lease; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality feels that declaring its intent to issue an RFP demonstrates the commitment of the Municipality to current users and the community regarding the Municipality's effort forward on the development, use, management, and preservation of the Port of Skagway, and the importance of planning to transition from the current long-term lease;


