A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA EXPRESSING THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY'S INTENT TO CONTROL AND MANAGE THE PORT OF SKAGWAY POST-2023.


WHEREAS, the Municipality of Skagway owns the Port of Skagway, including the Small Boat Harbor, tidelands, and uplands as detailed in Alaska Tidelands Survey #4; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality intends to directly manage the Port of Skagway post-2023, through a mechanism to be determined by a Request for Proposals (RFP) for the development, use, and preservation of the Port of Skagway; and

WHEREAS, as part of the transition to complete management and control of the Port of Skagway, the Municipality intends to acquire ownership of all useable infrastructure in the Port of Skagway through the RFP process, the operation of the current tidelands lease, or through any other process determined to be in the best interests of the community of Skagway; and


