**MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA
RESOLUTION NO. 20-45R**


A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA, PROVIDING ELIGIBILITY FOR CHILD CARE PROVIDERS TO BE CONSIDERED FOR POTENTIAL FUNDING UNDER RESOLUTION NO. 20-43R, COMMUNITY FUNDING GRANTS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Assembly of the Municipality of Skagway that child care providers are considered for potential funding under Resolution No. 20-43R, Community Funding Grants, as follows:


- A. **For fiscal years 2021, 2022, and 2023:** For-profit child care providers, including those operated by individuals or organizations, will be considered as eligible for potential Community Funding Grants under Resolution No. 20-43R for one application per fiscal year. Eligible organizations must be Licensed Child Care Providers through the State of Alaska Dept. of Health and Social Services.
- B. **For fiscal year 2024 and all subsequent fiscal years:** Community Funding Grants will only be available to non-profits, not-for-profits, or applicants fiscally sponsored by a non-profit, pursuant to Resolution No. 20-43R.
- C. A written communication will be provided to Skagway child care providers with current known addresses indicating this funding opportunity.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption, and shall expire on January 1, 2024.
