**MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA
RESOLUTION NO. 21-18R**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA ACCEPTING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,000,000 FROM NORWEGIAN CRUISE LINES FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING ECONOMIC RELIEF TO THE SKAGWAY COMMUNITY, DUE TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY RELATED TO THE CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) PANDEMIC.

WHEREAS, Norwegian Cruise Lines pledged \$10 million to Southeast Alaska communities whose tourism-based economies were devastated by COVID-19 and the loss of their cruise ships seasons due to the pandemic; and

WHEREAS, Norwegian Cruise Lines pledged \$2 million of this amount to Skagway; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Skagway wishes to distribute the \$2 million directly to the community of Skagway in order to provide economic relief; and


WHEREAS, the donated funds are specifically not payment or compensation for services or anticipated or expected services to Norwegian Cruise Lines or any subsidiary or affiliated company of Norwegian Cruise Lines, now or in the future; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Skagway intends to distribute the donated funds directly into the community via municipal donations, programs, and/or grants, to be separately developed by Administration and approved by the Assembly.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Municipality of Skagway Borough Assembly, that the Municipality of Skagway hereby accepts the \$2,000,000 donation from Norwegian Cruise Lines, to be deposited in the General Fund and held until such time that the Assembly approves its use.

Section 1. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
