ORDINANCE NO. 21-10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA AMENDING THE FY21 GENERAL FUND TO ALLOCATE A PORTION OF THE NORWEGIAN CRUISE LINES DONATION TO ENTITIES AND PROGRAMS THAT PROVIDE ECONOMIC RELIEF TO THE SKAGWAY COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Skagway accepted a \$2,000,000 donation from Norwegian Cruise Lines (NCL) for the purpose of providing economic relief to the community due to the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic, pursuant to Resolution No. 21-18R; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality wishes to allocate \$350,000 of these funds to the following community entities and programs: Food Bank, Skagway Traditional Council, and the Skagway Development Corporation – Community Development Services (SDC-CDS) Utility Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, after this portion of the donated funds is allocated, the Municipality intends to further allocate the remaining donated funds in the amount of \$1,650,000 to the community via a separate future ordinance, after additional Assembly meeting discussion;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. To amend the FY21 General Fund to allocate a portion of the Norwegian Cruise Lines donation to entities and programs that provide economic relief to the Skagway community.

Section 3. Amendment. The FY21 Municipality of Skagway Budget is hereby amended as follows:


Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
