**ORDINANCE NO. 21-12**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA AMENDING THE FY21 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO ALLOCATE A PORTION OF THE NORWEGIAN CRUISE LINES DONATION TO FUND SMALL BUSINESS ASSISTANCE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Municipality of Skagway accepted a \$2,000,000 donation from Norwegian Cruise Lines (NCL) for the purpose of providing economic relief to the community due to the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic, pursuant to Resolution No. 21-18R; and

**WHEREAS**, the Municipality wishes to allocate \$1,200,000 of these funds for assistance to qualifying businesses in accordance with criteria to be determined by the Assembly and approved by resolution;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Classification.** This is a non-code ordinance.

**Section 2. Purpose.** To amend the FY21 General Fund to allocate \$1,200,000 of the Norwegian Cruise Lines donation to fund small business assistance.

**Section 3. Amendment.** The FY21 Municipality of Skagway Budget is hereby amended as follows:

**Section 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


