RESOLUTION NO. 21-37R**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA, AUTHORIZING STAFF TO DEVELOP A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH YUKON ENERGY FOR SHORE POWER AT THE PORT OF SKAGWAY.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Skagway has undertaken a major port redevelopment planning process, and one of the objectives is identifying opportunities for a cleaner, more energy-efficient port; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality intends to consider conducting a feasibility study for electrification of the Port of Skagway for ferry and cruise vessels, including the infrastructure needed to power an electric ferry; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality recently initiated discussions with Yukon Energy about providing shore power for cruise ships and an electric ferry at the Port of Skagway; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality wishes to formalize in a memorandum of understanding (MOU) its intent to work with Yukon Energy on its shared goal of developing shore power at the Port of Skagway;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Municipality of Skagway Borough Assembly authorizes staff to develop a mutually acceptable MOU with Yukon Energy for developing shore power at the Port of Skagway, for future review and consideration for approval by the Assembly.
