RESOLUTION NO. 22-14R

A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA DIRECTING THE BOROUGH CLERK TO SCHEDULE A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PLACING A QUESTION BEFORE THE VOTERS REGARDING THE RATIFICATION OF ORDINANCE 22-03R

WHEREAS, the Borough Assembly may, by resolution, call a special election at any time, which shall fix the date of the election, per SMC 2.12.010(C); and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 22-03R, Authorizing the Municipality of Skagway to Negotiate the Sale of the E.A. & Jenny Rasmuson Community Health Center Real Property, Improvements, Personal Property, and Financial Assets to the Southeast Alaska Regional Health Consortium, and submitting to the Qualified Voters a Proposition Authorizing the Negotiated Sale, was adopted by the Borough Assembly on May 5, 2022, and must be ratified by the voters before it becomes effective; and

WHEREAS, SMC 16.02.025(A) requires that thirty (30) days' notice shall be given of the election, and during that period the Borough Assembly shall have published in the municipality a notice stating the time of the election and the place of voting, describing the property to be leased, giving a brief statement of the essential terms and conditions of the proposed lease, and stating the time and date of passage of the ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Skagway Borough Assembly directs the Borough Clerk to schedule a special election for July 12, 2022, and to place the following question before the voters:


“Shall the Municipality of Skagway sell the Dahl Memorial Clinic real property, improvements, personal property, and financial assets to SEARHC for an amount no less than market value established by a qualified commercial appraiser? and shall Ordinance No. 22-03 authorizing this negotiated sale be approved?”
