A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA DIRECTING THE BOROUGH CLERK TO SCHEDULE A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PLACING A QUESTION BEFORE THE VOTERS REGARDING THE RATIFICATION OF ORDINANCE 22-10

WHEREAS, the Borough Assembly may, by resolution, call a special election at any time, which shall fix the date of the election, per SMC 2.12.010(C); and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 22-10 directed the Borough Clerk to Place a Proposition on a Special Election Ballot for Ratification;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Skagway Borough Assembly directs the Borough Clerk to schedule a special election for April 18, 2023, and to place the following question before the voters:


“Shall the rate of sales tax collected upon sales made and services rendered in Skagway be increased from 5% to 6.5% for increased operational and infrastructural demands during the 2nd and 3rd quarters of each calendar year, April through September?
