RESOLUTION NO. 24-06R

A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA REPEALING AND REPLACING RESOLUTION 23-09R TO REALLOCATE THE ROYAL CARIBBEAN CRUISE LINE \$75,000 DONATION TOWARDS SENIOR PROGRAMS AND FACILITY

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Skagway hosted Royal Caribbean Cruise Lines President's Cruise on June 2022; and

WHEREAS, during the RCCL President's Cruise festivities, RCCL President Michael Bailey indicated that they would like to donate towards a community project; on February 14, 2023, RCCL submitted a letter indicating that the donation amount would be \$75,000; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Assembly adopted Resolution 23-09R which allocated \$50,000 of the RCCL donation towards the outfitting of the 21st & State Street property as a senior facility, should it be leased, and \$25,000 of the RCCL donation towards the hire of a senior programs and senior facility coordinator; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality has adjusted its operations to provide senior activities services through a Recreation Center program instead of through a contracted senior program and facility coordinator; and


WHEREAS, there is currently \$75,000 of the RCCL donation remaining and the Assembly would like to reallocate the funds to the municipal budget in support of senior activities programming through the Recreation Center; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Skagway Borough Assembly would like to allocate \$60,000 of the RCCL donation towards the outfitting of a senior facility, should one be identified; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Skagway Borough Assembly would like to allocate \$15,000 of the RCCL donation towards the budget for senior activities programming to be provided through the Skagway Recreation Center;

PASSED AND APPROVED by a duly constituted quorum of the Borough Assembly of the Municipality of Skagway this 4th day of April, 2024.
