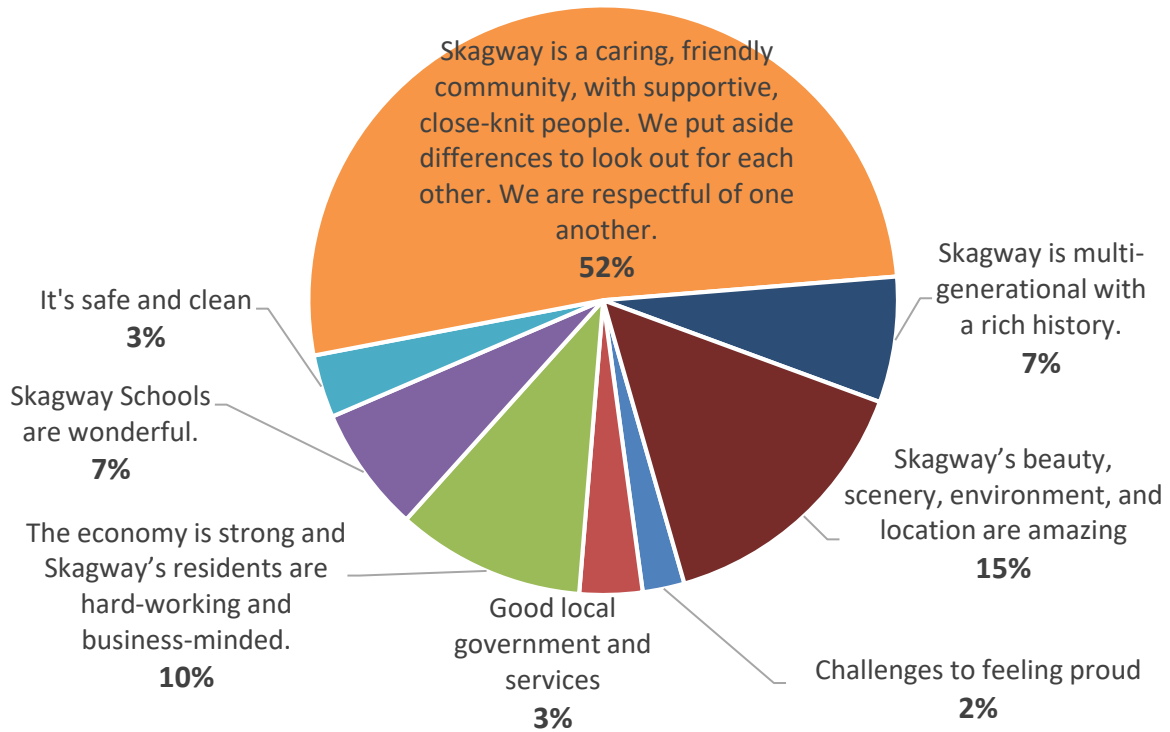

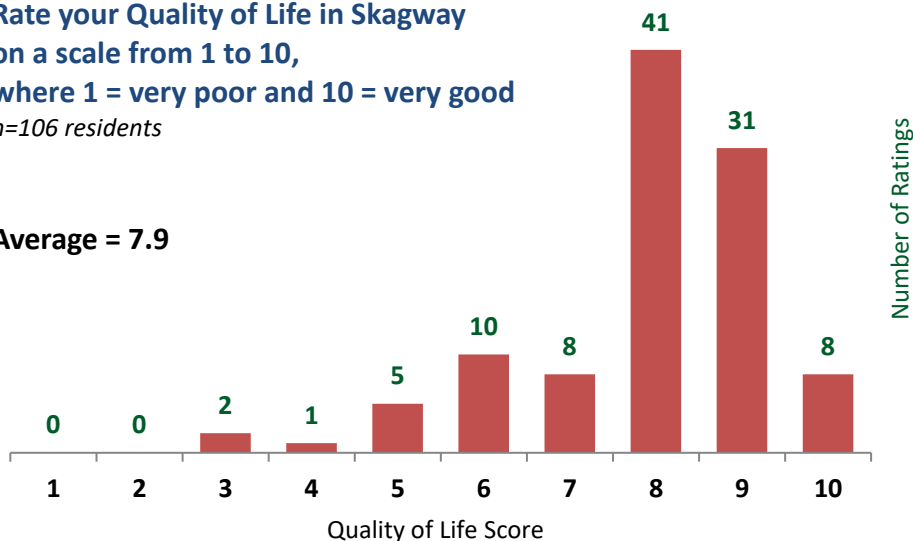

n=106 residents

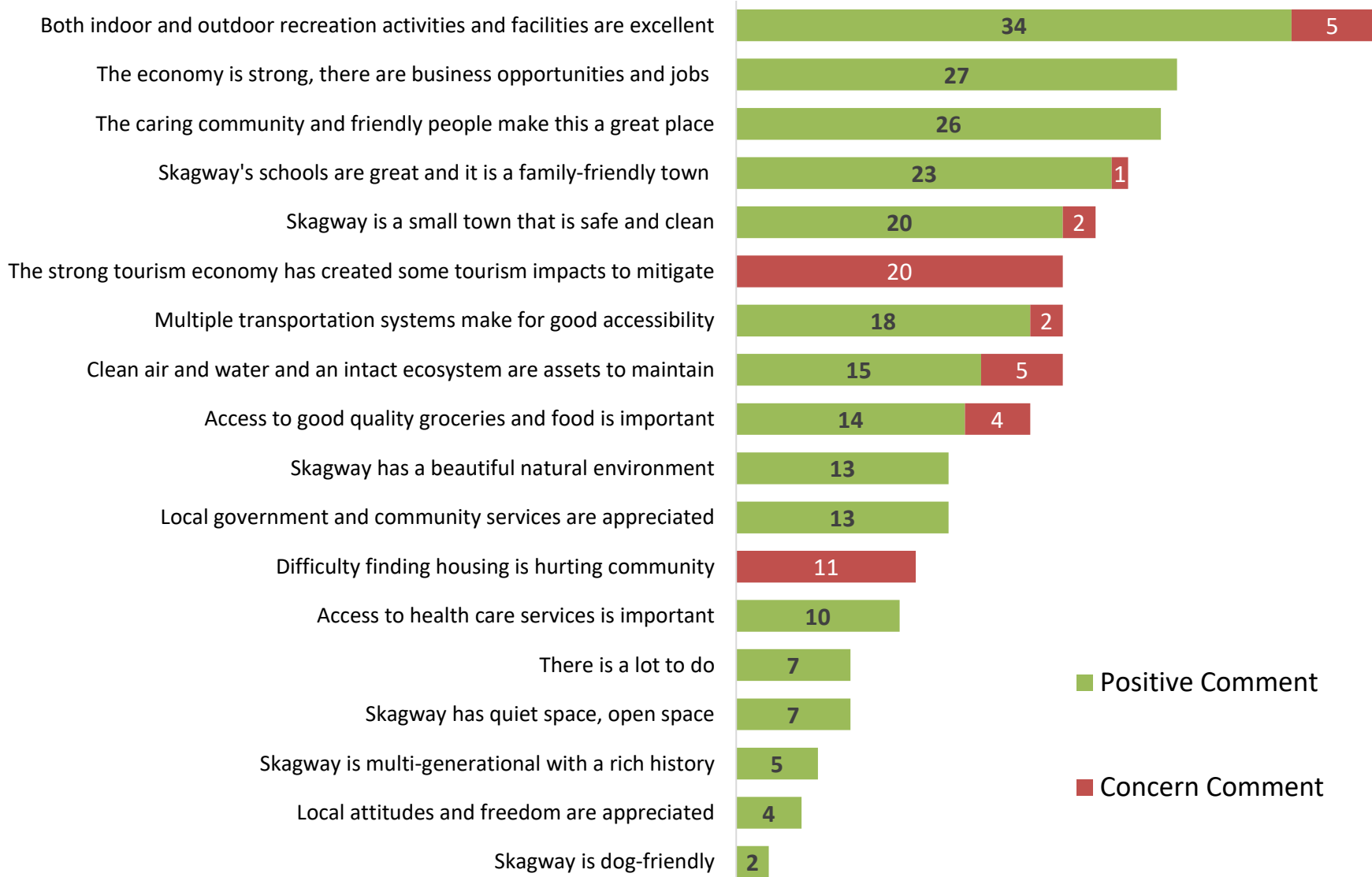
Average = 7.9

28	Wastewater treatment plant assessment and capacity upgrades

15	Better pedestrian street crossing control management along Broadway
10	Better wayfinding signage around/to docks and through town
