

WHAT IS A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN?

Comprehensive plans are 'big-picture' documents—they look 10–20 years into the future to confirm a community's goals and are used as the legal basis for zoning. By bringing together diverse voices, they guide decisions on community growth, land use, housing development, transportation and infrastructure investment, recreation, and public services.

Comprehensive plans for the future are grounded in today's economic opportunities and challenges. A useful comprehensive plan must tackle the issues that matter to residents—it must reflect community values and local conditions. It is not unusual for zoning and other code changes to be adopted to help acheive the desired vision.
